



EXTERNSHIP INFORMATION - PET POISON HELPLINE

- Pet Poison Helpline, a 24/7 animal poison control center based near Minneapolis, MN, accepts externship applications from 3rd and 4th year veterinary students registered in AVMA accredited veterinary schools.
- We will accept students for 1 or 2-week block rotations only, with a maximum of 10 externs/year.
- Rotation hours are typically 8 am – 5 pm, Monday – Friday. No weekend or night shifts are required, although there is opportunity if this is desired.
- Dress is generally casual, except for occasional days when client visitors are present, and business casual attire is required (you will be informed of this prior to the day, if applicable).
- No equipment is necessary.
- Once accepted into the program, the following information must be submitted no later than one month before your rotation start date:
 - You must provide a letter from the Office of the Dean that you are a full-time student, in good academic standing, eligible to enter your 3rd or 4th year.
- There are NO tuition costs.
- A confidentiality agreement must be signed at the start of the externship. All material is proprietary and no electronic or hard copies may be removed from the premises.
- Parking is complimentary at our facility.
- A cafeteria is in the building with breakfast, lunch, and snack items for purchase.
